

CAMS 2026 Spring Classic Registration Information

Date: 30 May 2026

Location: Fredericton High School Cafeteria, Priestman St., Fredericton, NB

Registration: 9:00 am to 12:00 pm

Fees:

Adult: Judging \$15.00 for the first five (5) kits, in any category. Additional kits - \$3.00 each.

Adult: Display \$15.00 – The number of kits for display will be based on space availability.

Building Tables; \$15.00 – For a table to display/build only in the Vendor's area – Limited Availability

Junior: Free if entered in the Junior category. Open to ages up to 12. Note: Models judged in the Junior category are not eligible for Best in Show.

Intermediate: Free if entered in the Intermediate category. Open to ages 13-17. Note: Models judged in the Intermediate category are not eligible for Best in Show.

Vendors: \$25.00 per table. Note: Vendors tables must be booked prior to show to guarantee space

Door Prizes: Again, this year our sponsors have furnished some great prizes.

Note: All modellers registered for Judging or Display are eligible for the door prizes but must be onsite to receive a door prize.

Theme/Special Categories:

Modelers **MUST** note on the registration form which kits are to be included in the Theme/Special Categories. If not noted, they **WILL NOT** be considered.

Proxy Wars of the 20th Century – This theme includes all military subjects—aircraft, armor, naval vessels, figures, artillery, vehicles, and dioramas—connected to conflicts influenced or sustained by outside powers. Eligible entries may represent combat, training, logistics, peacekeeping, or occupation forces from proxy conflicts such as Korea, Vietnam, Afghanistan, the Arab–Israeli conflicts, Angola, Central America, and other Cold War–era struggles.

T & A — Ford Model T and Model A Eligible entries include any scale model depicting a Ford Model T (1908 to 1927) or Ford Model A (1927 to 1931) in civilian, commercial, or service use. Subjects may represent factory stock vehicles, period-modified cars, delivery vans, trucks, race cars, or vehicles adapted for military, police, agricultural, or utility roles.

All models must be constructed by the Entrant (if represented, the builder's name must be registered) from one or more marketed kits (plastic or resin) or from scratch.

Note: Models that have been awarded a metal in previous CAMS shows are not eligible to be judged again but may be placed on the display tables.

Modelers may enter as many categories as they wish. **Maximum four (4)** kits per category.

Many food locations are within walking distance of the venue.
